- 50 amp electrical panel
- 8- 20 amp duplex receptacles wired to panel
- 2- marine deep cycle batteries wired to 2- 10 12 volt power strips with disconnect
- Interior walls to be lined
- 17 feet of overhead cabinets
- 14 feet of bench seating with hinged storage below
- 24 square feet of laminated desktop
- 12 volt DC interior lighting wired to marine batteries with switch
- 120 volt AC lighting wired to electrical panel
- Linoleum flooring

Proposals must be received on or before 12:00 noon EST Thursday, Dec. 13, 2012 to be considered.

C. Right of Refusal

Region 8 Homeland Security Board / Schoolcraft County reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to negotiate separately with any source whatsoever in any manner necessary to attend to the best interest of the County, to waive irregularities in any proposal and to accept a proposal which best meets the needs of Region 8 Homeland Security Board/ Schoolcraft County, irrespective of the bid price.

D. Disclosure of Proposals

Proposals are subject to disclosure under the Michigan Freedom of Information Act (Act 442, P.A. 1976, as amended, being MCL 15.231 through 15.246). After a contract award a summary of total price information for all proposals will be furnished upon request.

E. Price Determination

By submitting a proposal you certify, and in case of a joint proposal, each party certifies as to its own organization, that in connection with this proposal:

1). The prices in its proposal have been determined independently without consultation, communication or agreement, for the purpose of restricting competition, as to any matter relating to such prices with any proposing party or with any other competitor;

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- 2). Unless otherwise required by law, the prices which have been quoted in the proposal have not been knowingly disclosed to any competitor; and
- 3). No attempt has been made or will be made by the proposing party to induce any other person or firm to submit a proposal for the purpose of restricting competition.
