
“New Business”: John Stapleton, Public Transit Director, addressed the request from MDOT and ALTRAN (Alger County Transit Authority) for assistance with equipment and buses so the ALTRAN can resume normal operations after the fire they had at their building in Munising on Wednesday, March 4, 2015. There was discussion. **It was moved by Commissioner Larry Mersnick and was seconded by Commissioner Craig Reiter to authorize John Stapleton, Public Transit Director, to offer ALTRAN on loan a 2008 bus that had just been replaced here in Schoolcraft county, a phone system, and handheld radios.** There shall be an agreement signed between ALTRAN and John Stapleton, Public Transit Director, as to the repair of the equipment if damaged while in their possession. The motion carried by an unanimous aye vote of the Board members present.
