It is the contractor/homeowner's responsibility to set up a final inspection before occupancy. Call the Electrical Inspector 48 hours in advance to set up the appointment for inspection (give location and permit #) Manistique Office phone 906-341-3679 or Mike Rozek, Electrical Inspector, home phone 906-249-5106. Expiration of permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A permit will be cancelled when no inspections are requested and conducted within six months of the issuance or the date of a previous inspection. Cancelled permits cannot be reinstated.

APPLICANT SIGNATURE

Section 23a of the State Construction Act of 1972, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, being Section 125.1523a of the Michigan Compiled Laws, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or a residential structure. Violators of Section 23a are subject to civil fines.

PLAN REVIEW REQUIREMENTS

Plans and specifications for new construction work, alteration, repair, expansion, addition, or modification work shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal. A PLAN REVIEW IS REQUIRED BEFORE A PERMIT CAN BE ISSUED.

- Exception 1: Alterations and repair work determined by the electrical official to be of a minor nature.
- Exception 2: Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.
- Exception 3: A building of use group R-3 or R-4 containing not more than 3,500 square feet of building area.
- Exception 4: Wiring or alteration to an electrical system that costs less than \$10,000, unless requested by administrative authority.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Electrical Department. All installations shall be in conformatnce with the National Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.

The name of the inspector and the telephone number will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the location and permit number.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OF THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REINSTATED.
